Length of Test

The test contains 20 multiple choice style questions.

Type of Questions

All questions are "multiple choice." This means you will see a question and multiple possible responses. There could be as many as six but, typically, there will be four options. You will need to select one of these options as a correct answer (Example A). Sometimes, directions will ask you to select two or more correct answers (Example B).

Also, many of the questions require the test taker to use a given image or map to refer to when answering the question. (Example C)

Example A

Who established an era of peace as the first Emperor of Rome?

- A. Pompey
- B. Julius Caesar
- C. Augustus Caesar
- D. Mark Antony

Correct response is C

Example B

Which democratic principles originated in ancient Athens?

- A. Trial by jury
- B. Public debate

- C. Republic
- D. Duties of a citizen
- E. Direct democracy
- F. Innocent until proven guilty

Correct Responses: B, D, E

The ancient written language shown above is characteristic of which civilization?

- A. Sumer
- **B.** India
- C. Egypt
- **D.** Phoenicia

Correct Response is C
